Graphing Calculator is a software tool currently being used in our Calculus I classes for illustrating specific examples. In this talk, we will demo graphing activities such as transforming functions, exploring limits graphically, understanding the limit definition by sketching specific neighborhoods and illustrating the derivative definition by drawing secant lines.
