The canonical genus of a knot K is the minimum genus among all surfaces built by Seifert's algorithm for a projection of K. We prove, for an alternating pretzel knot K, that the canonical genus of its Whitehead doubles W(K) is equal to the crossing number c(K) of K, verifying a conjecture of Tripp in the case of these knots.
