In the study of resonance varieties, one uses specific configurations of points and lines in \mathbb{P}^2 called nets and multinets. Very few examples of multinets are known. Furthermore, there is a conjecture that every multinet is a degeneration of a net. In this work, numerous new examples of multinets are exhibited, each which is a degeneration of a net.
