The objective of this presentation is to study the large time asymptotic of the exponential moment: $\mathbb{E}_x \exp \left\{ \pm \int_0^t V(X(s)) ds \right\}$, where $\{X(s)\}$ is a d -dimensional Ornstein-Uhlenbeck process and $\{V(x)\}_{x \in \mathbb{R}^d}$ is a homogeneous ergodic random Poisson potential. It turns out that the positive/negative exponential moment has e^{ct} growth/decay rate, which is different from the Brownian motion model studied by Carmona and Molchanov in 1995 for positive exponential moment and Sznitman in 1993 for negative exponential moment.
