In the 1920s, American mathematicians returned to their pre-WWI research agendas with renewed vigor at the same time that they trained a next generation. This talk will survey the lay of the American mathematical landscape during that decade by locating mathematicians within their varied institutional settings, by gauging their appetite for mathematical research, and by taking, as a case in point, American geometrical research.
