At Brown University, graduate students have the luxury of a first year free of teaching responsibilities, but they have a heavy course load and many demands on their time during that year. As a result, we are able to deliver a teacher training program for first-years during the spring semester (which I have overseen for four years) but our time with these students is limited to one hour per week.

In this talk, I will discuss the structure of this program and how I aim to accomplish as much as possible in a total of thirteen hours, hoping that this will help other schools with similar time constraints to introduce or modify programs of their own.
