The Sciences have held that the application of the System/Sub System paradigm is secondary to the physical attributes of objects usually within Time and Space. I attempt to show any existential object can be Mathematically modeled as a System and/or Sub System. I claim that this successfully explains much already known physical behavior and uncovers possible existential behavior. Such as a Non-Functional component found in all existential systems.
