Two subgroups A and B of a group G permute if AB=BA. A subgroup M of a finite group G is then called Sylow-permutable if for all Sylow subgroups S of G, M and S permute. We provide a characterization of Sylow-permutable subgroups of a direct product, and discuss related aspects of permutability in direct products. (Received September 20, 2000)
