Faculty in the Math Department at Southwestern University adapted seven labs for use in our Calculus I course from the MAA "Resources for Calculus" and Texas Instruments "CBL Experiment Workbook." To create the time for these in class the three hour course was converted into a four credit hour course that meets five days a week. The labs involve a variety of applications and encourage group discovery of Calculus concepts. The students leave the labs with a deeper understanding of the concepts and are truly excited about their Calculus class.
