NWMI started in the early 90s as a group of teacher participants in the Park City Mathematics Institute who gathered in Seattle during the academic year to do mathematics with mathematicians at the University of Washington. In 1995 the group began organizing and presenting weeklong summer programs (17 so far) and academic-year Saturday workshops, with an emphasis in geometry. A hallmark of the group has been the collegial and informal interaction and shared leadership among the secondary and university members of the group.
