In an effort to increase graduation rates, Chicago State University replaced a three-semester Developmental Mathematics sequence with a single semester course, with students meeting eight hours per week. We will discuss how successfully this course prepared students for college-level mathematics, whether it impacted graduation rates and retention rates, and how the University is adjusting its Developmental Mathematics model for the future.
