African Americans are significantly under represented among US citizens receiving PhDs in the mathematical sciences and among the faculties of US departments and graduate programs granting PhDs in the mathematical sciences. These facts are closely related and are well documented. The web site <http://www.math.buffalo.edu/mad/> created by Professor Scott Williams in 1997 has been an influential and heavily used resource on the contributions of Africa and the African Diaspora to mathematics. A group of mathematicians is working to convert Scott Williams' site into a searchable database. We will introduce this new site www.mathad.com and discuss ways in which the web can be used effectively to help produce African American math PhDs and enhance their research careers.
