This talk focuses on the legacy of Polish mathematicians and the Polish School of mathematics at Warsaw University in 1965. The author, a first year student of mathematics at that time, will share reflections on: Helena Rasiowa, Stanislaw Mazur, Andrzej Mostowski, and Karol Borsuk and their teaching assistants who became well known mathematicians. Their contributions to different areas of mathematics together with the magic of their intellectual creativity and of unique inspiration will be described.
