In 2018 I taught several instances of a one-hour population modeling class for advanced high school students. The main goal of the course was to introduce students to modeling processes and techniques in a life science context. In the class, students worked in groups to develop and interpret discrete and continuous models of population growth, predator-prey interactions, and competition. The course also included brief discussions of other modeling approaches and challenges.
