Cathy S Liebars* (liebars@tcnj.edu). Math homework videos on Flipgrid. Preliminary report. Flipgrid is a simple, free, and accessible video discussion experience for educators and their learners. The presenter will describe the use of Flipgrid for presentation of homework problems in a capstone-like course for preservice teachers called Topics in Secondary Mathematics from an Advanced Viewpoint. Homework is assigned regularly and each student in the class chooses a homework problem that they will present by making a Flipgrid video. They do this a total of five times over the course of the semester. This determines their homework grade. Flipgrid allows for video responses so other students can view the homework videos and make a video comment or ask a question. This experience, including an example and the rubric used for evaluation, will be shared and discussed. (Received September 14, 2020)
