Miro, as described on its website, “is a collaborative online whiteboard platform designed for remote and distributed teams.” While geared primarily for use by industry, Miro’s unbounded whiteboard is both easy to use and rich in features, including free-hand drawing, drag-and-drop incorporation of files, and basic team management.
