In 1946 R. L. Moore, responding to a prospective student's request for information about graduate study, closed with a personal note, "Please remember me to Miss Mullikin." Many years earlier, in 1924, the Polish mathematician Stefan Mazurkiewicz published a paper with the title, "Remarque sur un thorne de M. Mullikin." We will discuss the life, personality and mathematics of the mysterious Mademoiselle Mullikin, who played an important role in the development of connectedness and the internationalization of topology in the 1920s.
