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Planar algebras are algebras which have an action by certain kinds of planar pictures. Knot diagrams are an example of a planar algebra, and a planar algebra homomorphism from knot diagrams to the Temperley-Lieb algebra gives rise to the Jones polynomial. Homomorphisms to other planar algebras give different knot invariants. I will show how to construct these invariants, and prove some interesting identities among colored Jones polynomials.
