LOGO PLACEMENT

Our logo can be placed in proximity to other logos so long as you follow the spacing requirements.

(at/least)/2/in. or 144/px.

Clear space around the logo should be no smaller than the width of the "A" of AMS

COLOR MANIPULATION

The AMS primary color is PMS 300 and should be used as the dominant color in all applications. The secondary colors are to be used as accents only and never without the primary color.
